Where should I stay in Moscow?

What should I wear during the reunion?

What should I plan on for parking on campus?

Parking on week days requires either metered parking or a campus visitor parking pass. Metered parking or self-serve pay station parking can be paid for at the site with a credit card or change. You may obtain a visitors parking pass for \$3 a day at the Parking and Transportation Office on campus or online at <https://aims.parking.uidaho.edu/>. Visitor passes are valid in all colored lots until 12:00 a.m. for the date issued. Overnight parking must have a valid permit for the next day as well.

Can I bring my RV to stay in and park it on campus?

For events unrelated to the Kibbie Dome, RV parking in Lot 110 in the West end of Kibbie parking is free, no permit required. Visit <https://www.uidaho.edu/infrastructure/parking/parking-maps> for maps of different parking options.

Golf Tournament Info

Golf Tournament Rules

- 1) The outing will be in a scramble format of four man/ woman teams. If you do not register as a team, you will be assigned to a team as close to pledge class as possible.
- 2) We will tee off as 8:00 Saturday morning in either a shotgun start or successive tee times depending on the number of entries.
- 3) The team will use two drives for each team member per the front and back nines. After the drive is selected, each team member will hit from within 12 inches of that shot, with the next selected shot used until the hole is holed out. No gimme putts. If your selected shot is in the rough, the following shots must be played from the rough. The same for a shot in a bunker.
- 4) In lieu of handicaps, we will have moving tee boxes for each hole. If your team makes a birdie or better on a hole, they will move back one tee box on the following hole. If the team makes a bogey or worse on a hole, they move forward one tee box on the next hole. Every team starts on the silver tees.
- 5) Depending on the number of entries, prizes will be awarded to lowest score team, long drive men and women (from the team's tee box), long putt men and women).
