

ITEM	EXPLANATION	Comments
<b>Grade</b>	Most of the grade definitions are self-explanatory.	Consider those that fall “outside” of the K-12 range
<b>Not in School</b>	Youth between 5-19 years of age but are not attending school	Primary use for this category would be drop-outs. It is NOT the place to record pre-school youth (they are not K-12) or for home-school youth who should be placed in the approximate grade level that their age indicates.
<b>Farm</b>	Uses the US Census definition of “all persons living in a rural territory on places from which \$1000 or more of agricultural products were sold, or normally would have been sold in the reporting year	These definitions separate participants who live on producing farms (Farm) from those who live on acreages, but whose parents do not farm (Rural).
<b>Rural</b>	Persons who live in towns under 10,000 and in situations not report/fit as “Farm” in the above definition	
<b>Town/City 10K-50K</b>	Self-explanatory	
<b>Suburbs of cities over 50K</b>	This person is definitely NOT re-enrolling this year (Graduating Seniors) or they did not re-enroll all year and now it’s time for next year.	Caldwell
<b>Central City of 50 K</b>	Urban cities	Boise, Nampa, Meridian, Idaho Falls
