HOSTING PERIOD: June 24 – July 22, 2017 (Costa Rica and Norway)
July 21 – August 18, 2017 (South Korea)

- 14– 18 years old or adult chaperones
- Youth have limited English language skills, and host families should be prepared to communicate imaginatively

HOST FAMILY REQUIREMENTS

- You must have a child of the same gender and within 3 years of the hosted youth
- Families without children of the appropriate age may host an adult chaperone
- No special activities need to be planned, these youth want to experience American culture, make new friends, and improve their English by staying with your family
- This is a volunteer opportunity
- **You do not need to be involved with 4-H to host**
