



## Health and Safety Programming Report Form

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Each member organization shall host a minimum of two (2) health and safety programming events each semester with over 80% members and new members in attendance. The first program must be completed within the **first 8 weeks** of the semester. All events must be recorded using the Health and Safety Programming Report Form. Failure to meet minimum health and safety programming requirements per half semester will result in a **\$250** fine at either point in the semester, for a total of **\$500** if both are missed. Refer to article X of the By-Laws for further requirements.
