4-H Adult Helper: Thank you for teaching the visual arts and evaluating for impact. This youth survey may be used for youth 9 years and older. Effective evaluation works when a robust visual ats program is delivered. This means youth need time to learn art techniques and skills and they need time to practice. One or two art lessons will not provide quality impact data.

You are welcome to add information to the following questions.

Question 1. Enter one activity per line during this 4-H art experience. Add row(s) as needed.

Question 2. Add other media taught if needed to the first indicator Learn new art techniques for drawing, painting, or sculpting.

Do not change any other question or indicator.

For quality survey results from youth follow these steps:

- 1. Provide a sharpened pencil with eraser to each youth. This gives them the option to change their minds.
- 2. Explain that the survey is not a test, it just helps 4-H understand how well we delivered the art activities.
- 3. Each youth should only answer for themselves and not their friend. We need to know what they are thinking.
- 4. Share that all responses are anonymous and will not be shared with other youth.
- 5. Instruct youth that they may answer only the questions they are comfortable with and that they may stop taking the survey at any time.
- 6. Read each question and indicator aloud to reach a variety of learning styles (visual, auditory, tactile). Youth may proceed at their own pace, but all questions should be read aloud.
- 7. Have the youth place their survey in a big envelope labeled ART SURVEYS. This indicates that they have value, and their input is important.
